Hay to feed everyone through the winter - £3000



Food for the ponies, once they learn of its nice taste, they love it!



Office supplies and printing – a never ending drain on finances. We do the best we can.



Haynets – We fill 50 a day in winter when everyone needs hay.



Medical supplies – We need everything from wormer, antiseptic, antibiotics to fly repellent.



All the ponies need to be microchipped and passported when leaving the moor. Last year this cost us over £2000



Veterinary costs for colt castration, 70 ponies so far this year - £4200 to find!

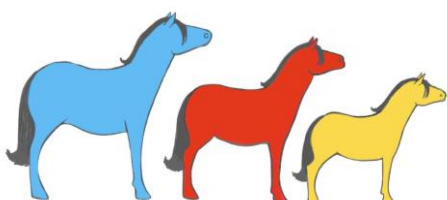


We never have enough lead ropes! And headcollars.
